WHAT TO EXPECT AFTER ROOT CANAL TREATMENT

Your dentist has taken measures to minimise discomfort during and after your root canal treatment.

However, it is not unusual to experience discomfort and tenderness for at least 3 to 4 days following the procedure. Consequently you may need to take regular pain relief medication during this time.

An anti-inflammatory medication such as Ibuprofen is generally the most effective.

PLEASE CONTACT US

If you experience any of the following symptoms please do not hesitate to immediately contact our office or phone your dentist if it is after hours.

- Swelling
- Throbbing sensation
- Loss of temporary filling
- Fracture of tooth

PLEASE NOTE

Teeth that have been root filled are structurally weaker. To strengthen and restore the tooth fully, it is likely that further treatment will be required. The generally recommended method to protect such a tooth is a crown.
